- "I think if I send emails into school to be passed around by teachers, it should be sent around. If I had a chance my child would not be coming here but she wants to"
- "School is improving and they inform me any concerns about my child. They call me any issues about my child. But then if parents need an appointment or concern, they don't help us"
- "*Child's name* has stated on numerous occasions that some children get away with bad behaviour, but more trivial matters are dealt disproportionately harsh"
- "We would love for the school to focus on young men's mental health and encourage reading, not through SPARX Reader, the use of actual books! Thank you"
- "We wish you to go ahead improving students' skills"
- "Would be nice if teachers and staff returned calls, when concerns are made"
- "Very good, keep it up. Thank you"
- "*Child's name* is shy, splitting her from her friends for lessons has not been helpful. Her form teachers have always been very supportive"
- "Better communication"
- "Parents evening is a sensory nightmare. Hard to access seating, a room that echoes and no clear queue area per teacher"
- "*Child's name* is improving well overall and I support the school. Providing more learning resources online or materials would be significant for him"

Actions following Parent Comments

- Breakfast is now served until 8.25am
- Message sent on Arbor to signpost parents and pupils to learning resources online
- Look into how to make Parents Evenings less overwhelming
- Introduce a half-termly HOY drop-in so parents can call into school and meet the pastoral to discuss issues which are concerning them
- Look into encouraging students to borrow books from the library rather than just complete reading on Sparx Reader
